Various seasonal job positions include:

Field work: The majority of employees will be hired for this position. This position will require working behind tractor and tree lifting equipment pulling trees out of the loosened soil, shaking soil from roots and rough counting into bundles of various quantity. Loading trees and transporting to our sorting facility where they will be graded and bundled/tied for storage or shipment. This may be considered hard work by most. Days may be chilly and wet or warm and sunny, you will need to come prepared for any weather condition. Another position would include setting baskets and tying of root balls for our B&B operation. You will be expected to fulfil any position within reason.

Sorting, grading and bundling: This position will require standing, sorting, counting, bundling of seedling and transplant trees. Work is generally done in our buildings where temps hover around 40-50 degrees.

Order pulling and packaging: For this position, employees will take a packing slip on a clipboard, access the cooler for the various tree seedlings on the order and package them at a work station. A couple of the employees trained for this will also be cross trained in shipping and carton assembly. *Skills required: Carefully looking at order, pulling correct nursery stock, counting and labeling accurately, packaging the seedlings into a box and including the proper paperwork with the order.*

Things to know about all of the positions

- All positions are seasonal and temporary. Employees hired this season will have first option at working future seasons.
- This season will kick off in early April and may run 4-6 weeks, depending on work load and staffing.
- Field work is strenuous satisfying work, if like working hard in the fresh country air.
- At times fields may be cold wet and slippery you must dress accordingly.
- There will be a good deal of standing at your work station during your shift. It is important to wear comfortable warm shoes/boots while working.
- We have no breakroom.
- You may be asked to assist customers load orders, a pleasant demeanor is a must.
